Fellow Residents of Carterville:

Today, Governor JB Pritzker announced a new Stay Home Executive Order requiring Illinois residents to stay home and continue social distancing through April 7, 2020. With that announcement, I felt it was important to update the residents and visitors of Carterville on our plans through April 7<sup>th</sup>.

The offices of Carterville City Hall and Carterville Water and Sewer Department will only be open to the public by appointment but will continue essential operations. As always, we do have the capabilities of receiving water bill payments online through our city website and have a dropbox on the northeast corner for payment and document drop off. We strongly encourage social distancing and the use of phones or internet to deal with the Carterville City Hall/Carterville Water and Sewer Department.

At this time, the Carterville Community Center, Cannon Park Pavilion and the Cannon Park Gazebo must cancel all reservations through April 7, 2020. Also, the City of Carterville playgrounds located at James Street Park and Cannon Park are closed through April 7, 2020.

Per the Governor's Executive Order, all non-essential businesses must close starting Saturday March 21, 2020 at 5:00pm and remain closed through April 7, 2020.
